



## INDEPENDENT READER (IR) SUMMER READING RULES

- Participants in the IR Summer Reading Program must be 7-9 years old. Participants are encouraged to read books at the Juvenile reading level.
- IR participants can earn prizes for time spent reading. Entries are awarded each time the participant logs 120 minutes (2 hours) of reading time. Color in each box for every 15 minutes read. Participants who read 15-30 minutes per day will easily finish their reading logs.
- Return finished reading logs to the Circulation Desk to be entered into the prize drawing. Participants will then be given bonus reading logs.
- Participants get entry forms for time spent reading, and can win 1 of 4 Grand Prize baskets. *The Grand Prize baskets include items such as gift cards, goodies, and more.*
- Prizes and completion certificates will be awarded at the Library Carnival on July 25, 2017. Certificates will be given only if reading logs (10 hours of reading) have been completed.
- The program begins June 17 & ends July 25, 2017. All reading logs must be turned in by 8pm July 21 in order to receive prizes
