3 Ways We Can Help Your Child Succeed THIS SCHOOL YEAR

1. **Research:** If you are an Allen Park Public Library cardholder, your child can get access to many great databases that can assist them with their



upcoming school projects. Does your child need to research information about a historical event? We can set them up on one of our computers so they can look through a few of our Facts on File Databases such as American History Online, Modern World History Online, or Ancient and Medieval History Online. They can also use the search bar on our homepage which will pull information from all of our online databases!

- 2. **Book Reports**: Does your child have a book report due soon but they don't know what to read? Try **NoveList K-8** to get recommendations based on your child's reading level and interests. You can find this resource on our homepage by clicking on the "Find Your Next Great Read" button.
- 3. **Test Prep**: Is your teen preparing for the ACT or the SAT? Check out one of our SAT Launchpad tablets so they can test their Math knowledge. They also have access to a database through the Library of Michigan where they can take practice exams for free!

FALL STORYTIMES

Preschool Storytime: Tuesdays at 1:00 P.M.

September 12, 19 & 26

For children ages 3-5 who can participate independently. Caregivers & siblings wait in the library.

Lapsit: Wednesdays at 10:15 A.M.

September 13, 20 & 27

For children under 2 years old only. One child per parent or caregiver.

Toddler: Wednesdays at 10:45 A.M.

September 13, 20 & 27

For children ages 2-3 with parent or other adult. Caregivers are required to participate.

No registration required. Sixteen program passes will be handed out at the circulation desk 15 minutes prior to the start of the program. Late arrivals will not be allowed to enter the meeting room.

STORYTIME GUIDELINES

Arrive Early: Allow you and your little one enough time to get settled before storytime begins. Storytimes start promptly at their scheduled time. **Once the meeting room door is closed, you and your child will not be permitted to attend storytime.**

Visit the Restroom: Leave enough time for a trip to the restroom before storytime begins. Children who need to use the restroom during storytime will not be allowed to re-enter the meeting room.

Courtesy to All: If a parent or guardian is in attendance (Lapsit & Toddler Storytimes), please silence your cell phones at the beginning of storytime. Please do not bring any snacks to storytime. We also ask that you leave your child(ren)'s stuffed friends or toys out in the library. **Caregiver participation is expected.**

Prepare for Storytime: Preschool Storytime is our only storytime where children go into the meeting room by themselves. Prepare your child to attend without an adult.

Behavior Expectations: Young children like to explore but doing so should not prevent others from enjoying their storytime. Please help encourage positive behaviors like good listening, following directions. and being respectful of people and things in the meeting room.


